A Quest staff member will reach out to discuss the child to determine if the program is appropriate for them and vice versa.



We may ask to talk to other individuals such as the child's teacher, therapist, etc. to get a better sense of their needs.



We will schedule an hour long screening appointment to take place at April's office with the child and their caregiver. \*There is a screening fee.
