How to Register a New Camper for Quest Camp as an ESY Placement

Are you a parent who is looking for a fun, safe and therapeutic environment for a child ages 6-18 to fulfill their IEP goals related to Extended School Year programming? Does Quest's system of positive behavior support and individualized goals sound like a good fit for your child's needs? Parents and school staff should discuss if the child qualifies for ESY and what types of programming might be a good fit.



The point person at the school and/or the child's parent should email*

to determine if the child might appropriate for Quest. They should include: referral source (if any), child's age, and school placement.
